IMPORTANT NOTES

- ❖ Most of the exams are two hours long – your subject teacher will confirm the exact times with you.
- ❖ **You** are responsible for having all the necessary equipment required for all the exams. Please **do not** expect the staff or invigilators to have supplies of calculators, coloured pencils etc.
- ❖ You **must** have a revision or a reading book with you at all times during the fortnight. If an exam finishes some time before a break, you will be asked to remain in the exam room in silence and revise until the ‘bell’. This is in order to avoid disruption to those still working and to the rest of the school.
