

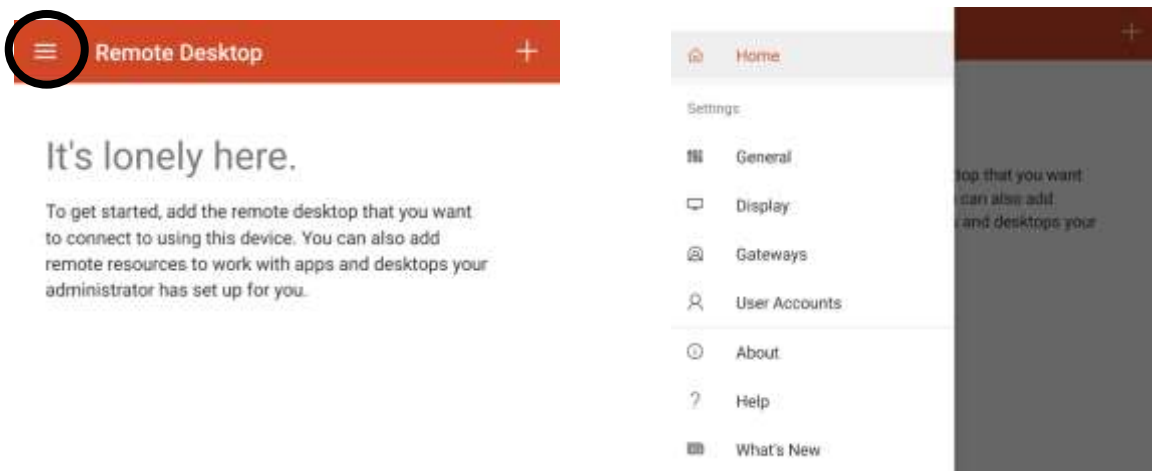
## Remote Desktop Access for Android and ChromeOS Devices

(Screenshots taken on an android phone, user interface may vary on ChromeOS)

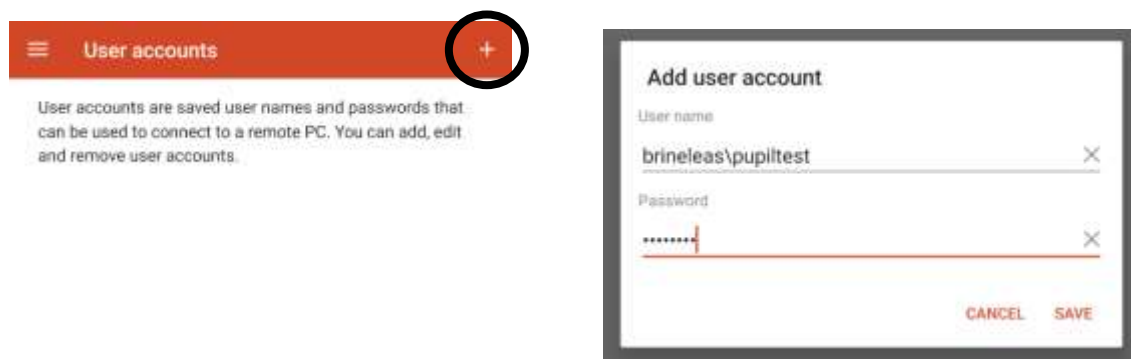
1. Download the Microsoft Remote Desktop App from the Google Play Store on your Andoid or ChromeOS device.



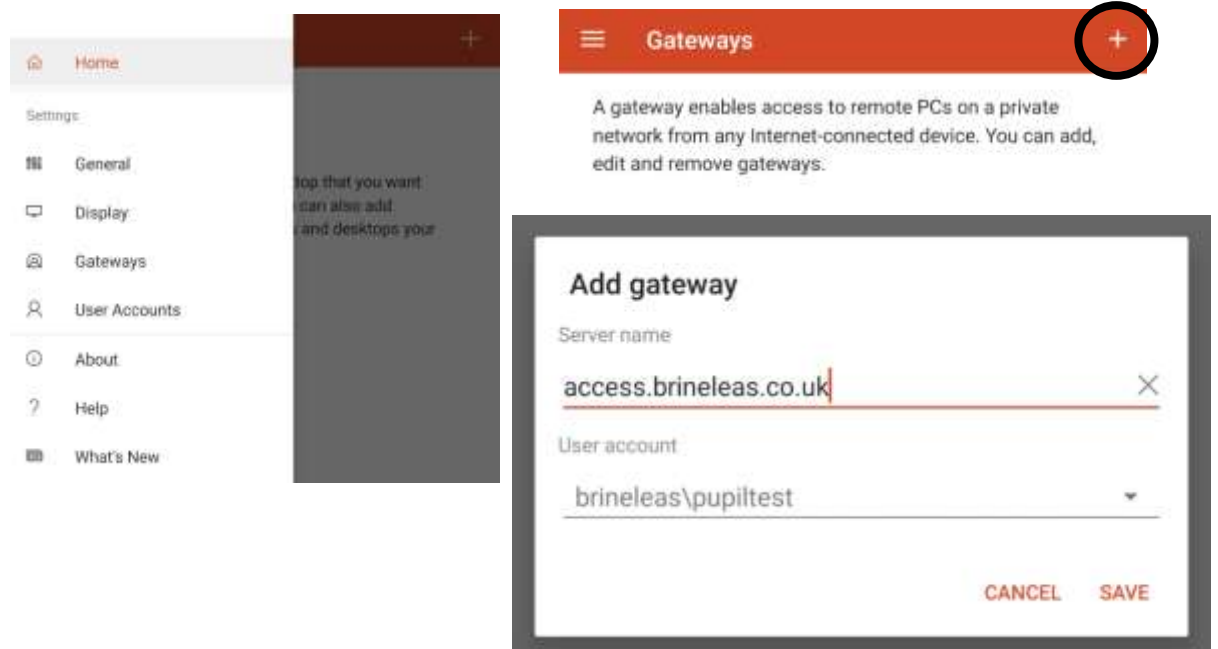
2. From the home screen of the app, select the three lines to open the menu. Select User Accounts.



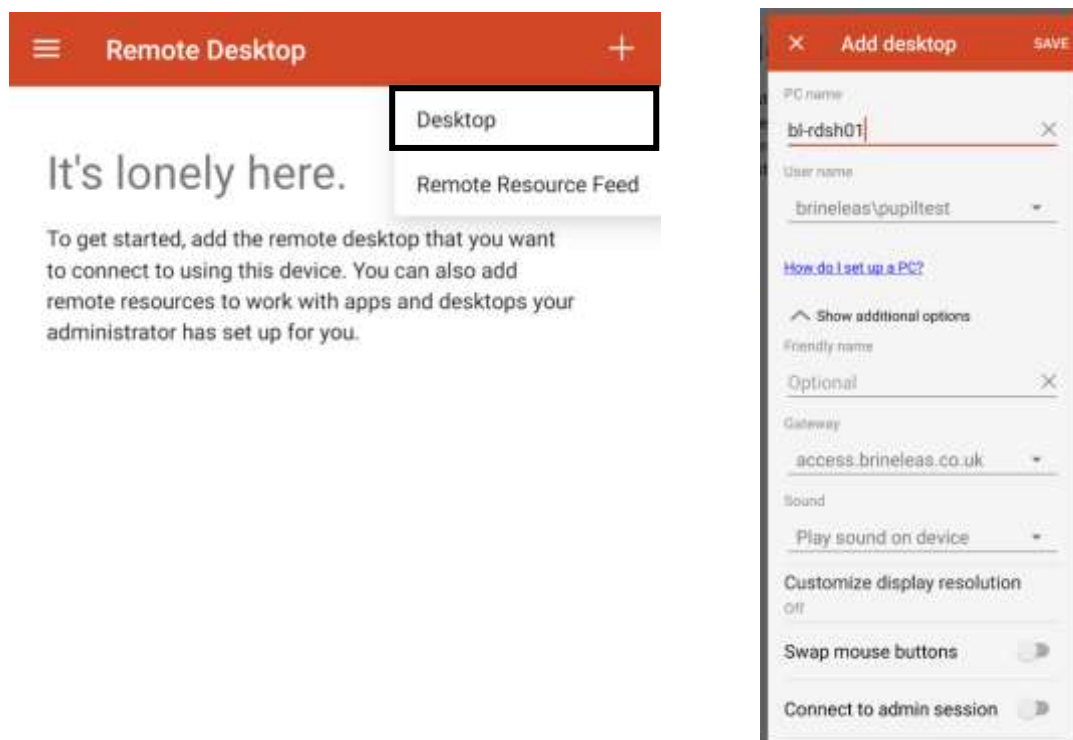
3. In the User Accounts section, press the plus icon (shown below left) and you will receive the following dialogue box (shown below right). Enter your username and password for the school computers with brineleas\ before the username as shown below, then click save.



4. Navigate back to the side menu and select gateways. Click the plus icon in the gateways section. Enter the server name access.brineleas.co.uk and select the user account you added in the previous step then click save.



5. Go back to the home page and click the plus icon, then click desktop. Enter the details as shown in the lower right screenshot. The PC name can be one of a few; bl-rdsh01, 02, 03 & 04 for main school students and bl-rdsh05, 06, 07 & 08 for sixth form students.



- A Remote desktop should now appear on the home screen. Click on this to start your remote session. If you see the message certificate cannot be verified, select connect and you will be connected to the remote session.
