



Generic Questions to ask your child if there is no AR Quiz for their book.

Before you start

- Why did you choose this book?
- What do you think will happen in the book?
- If this is a non-fiction book what do you hope to find out?

Halfway through

- What has happened so far?
- Who are the main characters?
- How do you think the main characters are feeling now?
- How would you describe the story so far? (For example, it could be *funny* or *exciting*).
- What might happen next?
- Questions about non-fiction books:
 - What have you learned so far?
 - What are you hoping to find out next?
 - What is the most interesting thing you have learned?

At the end

- Did you enjoy the book?
- What was the best part of the story?
- Would you recommend this book to a friend?
- Why would you recommend it or why wouldn't you?
- Would you choose more books by the same author? (If so, you could look for some).

When you have finished a book, you could check your understanding by trying some of these activities:

- Tell the story in your own words.
- Draw pictures or scenes or characters from the book.
- Write a letter to a character.
- Describe some of the main characters. Try to include their feelings, thoughts.
- Try to write down a different ending to the story.
- Make a list of the things you have learned from the book.
