

Printing from a Remote Desktop Session

Printers should map automatically, providing they are connected prior to signing into a remote session after a change earlier in the week.

But to ensure this is the case follow the steps below:

- Ensure before connecting to remote desktop your printer is on and attached to your laptop
- When connecting to a remote session, the following box should popup.
