Day 1	Your own reading Read for 20 minutes.	Language Features Go on to the shared area and find the "Tasks" doc here: Z:\Students\Read Only\Home Learning\Year 7\English\Travel Writing Title: Persuasive Language Look back at the online travel brochure for South Africa on the previous page (read last week). This piece of Travel Writing aims to persuade (encourage) tourists to visit South Africa. Remind yourself of the AFOREST language techniques used in persuasive writing, then create a table in your book like the one in the Task 7. Check the "Answers" doc afterwards for examples and mark your work! Stretch & Challenge: Choose ONE of the quotes from your table and 'explode' or annotate it to think of the effect. Then, write a PEE paragraph. Help for this can also be found in the "Answers" doc.
Day 2	Online Research Complete Task 8 from the "Tasks" doc on the shared area. What would be your ideal travel destination be and why? Discuss this with the people you live with! Then, conduct some research into this destination using Google (e.g. type in 'travel to Vancouver'): Where in the world is your destination? How can you get there? Climate and landscape Culture Cuisine (food and drink) Landmarks and iconic places of interest Entertainment Language Fun and interesting facts! Title: Travel Research In your exercise book, use a whole page to create a mindmap on your chosen destination, using this list to help. You should just draft the 3 paragraphs you plan to write in your exercise book today. How much persuasive language have you used? Think back to yesterday's work on the brochure from South Africa for help.
