### Lesson 1: Title: What do Muslims believe about life after death?

#### Starter Activity: Gap fill ANSWERS

Muslims believe in **one** God, who is referred to as **Allah**. They believe He **created** the world and has **power** over all things.

The Islamic religion was founded by **Prophet** Muhammad. He lived roughly 1400 years in the area surrounding **Makkah**. This remains a holy city for Muslims.

The Islamic holy book is the **Qur'an**. **Muslims** believe this is the direct **word** of God. This means Allah is its **author**, not Muhammad. Because of this, this book is incredibly precious to Muslims.

#### Activity 3 ANSWERS

### Indicative Answers

Key points students may pick out could include:

- Angels – record our deeds; question us in the grave; Israfil blows the trumpet to signal the end of the world.
- Day of Judgement – the day God decides our fate after death; judgement is fair; sent to heaven or hell based on actions in this life; gooddeeds weigh more than bad deeds.
- Heaven – a paradise; described as a garden.
- Hell – a place of punishment; fire.
- Allah – judge; all-powerful; fair; sent his guidance in the Qur'an for us to follow.

#### Activity 5

### Life After Death – Qur'an Analysis Answers

Read the quotations below and answer the questions.

'And be conscious of the Day on which you shall be brought back unto God, whereupon every human being shall be repaid in full for what he has earned, and none shall be wronged'

- Qur'an 2: 281

What is this quotation saying about life after death?

This quotation implies people will be resurrected ('brought back by unto God'). It also talks about people being repaid in a fair way. The implication here is that there will be rewards (heaven) and punishments (hell) after death.

'Lo\*! the righteous verily will be in delight. And lo! the wicked verily will be in hell; They will burn therein on the Day of Judgment, and will not be absent thence. Ah, what will convey unto thee what the Day of Judgment is... A day on which no soul hath power at all for any (other) soul. The (absolute) command on that day is Allah's.'

- Qur'an 82: 12-19

\* Lo is an ancient word that draws attention to something.

What is this quotation saying about life after death?

This quotation focuses on how those who have behaved well will be rewarded whilst those who have not will be punished with hell. It also states that on the Day of Judgement only God is in command.
