How should we approach learning at home for Religious Education?

How long should I spend on Religious Education each week?

You should be trying to follow your timetable – this means 2 hours of Religious Education per fortnight.

What should I be doing each day then?

Aim to spend 2 days a week doing 30 minutes of Religious Education per day.

There are some worksheets on the website as well to help complete activities if you are struggling accessing the school portal. **Ensure you check the link carefully, so that you are doing the activities set for the right week**.
