Dear Parent/Guardian

Re: Year 9 Able and Talented History visit to Imperial War Museum, Manchester, Monday 10th July 2017.

The History Department will be organising an optional extra visit to the Imperial War Museum in Manchester on Monday 10th July 2017. The visit is for 20 Able and Talented students in Year 9 to help develop their understanding of WW2 and the holocaust, but this will also give them an insight to GCSE History topics. The museum deals with conflict in the world during the 20th Century and we will be primarily concerned with the events of the Holocaust and the Second World War. The visit supports the work we will be doing in the Summer Term on responses to the Holocaust. Due to the sensitive nature of the Holocaust exhibition the Museum provides briefing and debriefing workshops as part of the programme.

The visit will leave Brine Leas at 9.30am and be returning by 3.30pm. Students should wear their school uniform and bring a packed lunch and some money for the Museum Shop.

We request a voluntary contribution to the cost of the visit of £14.00. Should we not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, the Headteacher may decide that the visit cannot take place.

Cheques should be made payable to Brine Leas School and returned with the permission slip in an envelope to the Drop Box outside Student Reception.

Cash payments can be accepted when a cheque is not possible. Students may take cash payments directly to the Finance Office and this will be receipted in the student's planner.

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals, a packed lunch can be provided by the school canteen. If you would like your child to receive a packed lunch please confirm on the permission slip attached.

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals / has in the past been on Free School Meals since 2011 / is currently a Child in Service since January 2011/ is currently a Cared for Child or has ever been looked after by an English or Welsh local authority then the visit will be paid for through the Pupil Premium Fund, please return the form attached with the Pupil Premium Payment option on the reply slip ticked. If your form is returned to school showing the Pupil Premium option and we don't appear to have your child on our Pupil Premium records we may need to contact you to clarify
