## Oxbridge Student Conference

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest in attending the Oxbridge Student Conference, which is scheduled to take place in Birmingham on 28 March 2017. This conference is run by Oxford and Cambridge and is an excellent opportunity for students to learn about courses, admissions procedures, university life and finance. If your son/daughter is interested in this route, attendance is highly recommended.

Attendance at the conference is free of charge, however, transport to and from Birmingham will be £12 per student; this has been heavily subsidised by BL6 to keep costs to a minimum. The minibus will depart BL6 at 7am and will return at approximately 6pm, traffic dependent. Students must ensure they either bring a packed lunch with them, or money to purchase lunch.
