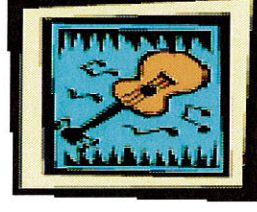

If you would like to pay for the whole year at the start of the term there is a saving of £15.00 making the total amount payable for the year £315.00.


Late payments for music tuition will be charged an additional £2.00 fee.
