Geography Fieldtrip—24th to 28th October 2016

Further to my letter of 26th September 2016, I would like to take this opportunity to provide you with additional information about the Geography fieldtrip.

I have studied the long range forecast and it would suggest that the weather will be mild and largely overcast, but dry. However, many years of experience on geography fieldtrips would lead me to believe that it is more likely to be cold, wet and windy! As weather at this time of year can be changeable, please ensure that your son/daughter is prepared with suitable clothing. Below is a suggested list of items to take:

Clothing:

- Waterproof shoes/boots are probably the best footwear for the national park, with alternative footwear for wearing around the town
- Waterproof jacket and trousers (if your son/daughter has then)
- Enough clothes for a week, including items suitable for a town centre (e.g. jeans, jumper, coat)
- Toiletries and towels

Additional items:

- Bag/rucksack for use when collecting data
- A small amount of spending money for additional items
- Pencil case, pens etc.
- Camera, mobile phone etc. at own discretion

Please ensure that any necessary medication is packed carefully and that staff are advised of this prior to leaving BL6.
