Dear Parents, Guardians, Carers

Re: Students who use the controlled crossing on Peter Destapleigh Way / Audlem Road


You may be aware that the controlled crossing between Peter Destapleigh Way and Audlem Road is currently out of order.

As a temporary measure we have been trying to help students cross the road in the morning and evening whilst the traffic lights are repaired. We have been pushing hard to get them fixed as soon as possible but we have now been told it may be three weeks until new lights are put in.

As a longer term measure I would ask for all students using Peter Destapleigh Way to walk to the zebra crossing on Audlem Road until the lights are in working order. In practical terms students coming to school from Peter Destapleigh Way will need to turn right, walk past the school, cross on the Zebra crossing and enter school using the small gate at the railway end of school. The opposite will happen after school. This does put a few minutes on journey times but at least it will help to keep our children safe.

Please can I ask that you discuss with your child and support the school on this issue.
