Curriculum Enrichment Week : 24th to 28th October 2016

During week commencing Monday 24th October 2016, all Year 12 students will be involved in Curriculum Enrichment Week and will follow an alternative timetable. Attendance at all scheduled sessions is compulsory and registers will be taken.

We have arranged various activities throughout the week including enrichment in each subject area as well as some extra curriculum activities including:

Certified First Aid Course

Upon completion, students will receive a certificate in First Aid Core Skills, which will prove invaluable when applying for jobs whilst at BL6, university and beyond.

Visit to Keele University

This visit will give students an insight into university life and will help with their decision making process regarding life after sixth form. The programme for the day will include seminars regarding the costs and benefits of a university education, as well as information about day to day university life. Specialist workshops will also be running to allow students to hone transferable skills in problem solving, data analysis and presenting to a small audience; these workshops will be beneficial to all students, irrespective of whether they plan to go to university post BL6. We will be departing BL6 at 9am and returning by 3pm. Please note, students should bring a packed lunch with them.

We request a voluntary contribution of £10 per student to cover the cost of the First Aid course and the travel costs to/from Keele University. If your son/daughter has applied for the BL6 Bursary, the cost may be paid for out of the Bursary Fund; please indicate this on the reply slip below.

It is the policy of Brine Leas to support families when financial hardship may preclude a student from participating in an event, so if there are any problems, please contact Mrs K Bradshaw and the matter will be dealt with confidentially.
