Dear Parents / Guardians,

On Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2016 the Brine Leas English and Drama Departments are running an exciting visit for the GCSE students to watch 'Blood Brothers' by Willy Russell at the Hippodrome Theatre in Birmingham. As your child is studying Blood Brothers, this will be extremely beneficial for their learning and success at GCSE.

The cost will be £36.50 per student and this cost will include: coach travel to and from Birmingham and tickets to watch the performance.

If you would like your child to attend the visit, please complete the permission slip attached and return it to school no later than Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2016.

Cheques should be made payable to **Brine Leas School** and returned to the Drop Box outside Student Reception.

Cash payments can be accepted when a cheque is not possible. Students must take cash payments direct to the Finance Office for a receipt to be provided.

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals/has in the past been on Free School Meals since 2009 / is currently or has been a Child in Service since January 2011 / is currently a Cared for Child or has ever been looked after by an English or Welsh local authority immediately before being adopted, left local authority care on a special guardianship or child arrangements order, then the visit will be paid for through the Pupil Premium Fund, please return the form attached with the Pupil Premium Payment option on the reply slip ticked. If your form is returned to school showing the Pupil Premium option and we don't appear to have your child on our Pupil Premium records we may need to contact you to clarify.

*It is the policy of Brine Leas to support families when financial hardship may preclude a student from attending a visit, therefore if you would like to request any assistance, please contact Mrs K Bradshaw and the matter will be dealt with confidentially.*

Students will be in lessons all day and leave school at 3:45pm. The performance begins at 7:30pm and is estimated to end at approximately 9:45pm. The coach will arrive back at school at approximately 11:30pm at which time students will need to be collected. As this is an approximate time, and is of course traffic dependant, all students will be given time to contact home with a clearer time of arrival on the day.

Students will require a packed evening meal with them that can be eaten upon arrival in Birmingham. Alternatively, if you would like you child to buy their evening meal they will be given the opportunity to do so in the Birmingham Bull Ring Shopping Centre. Once in the theatre, there will also be the opportunity to buy ice-cream and drinks so students may bring a small amount of money at your discretion.

Students must be in full school uniform for the school day; however they may change into non-school uniform at the end of the school day, before departing for the coach journey
