Dear Parent / Guardian

The Creative Arts Department is delighted to invite your child to a workshop and performance of Matthew Bourne's 'Red Shoes' at the Lowry Theatre in Salford on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2016. There will be a Dance workshop in the morning and we have tickets booked for the matinee performance. The visit is an excellent opportunity for students to see a high quality performance by a professional dance company and participate in an exciting workshop run by professionals.

The cost of the visit is £28.00 which covers the coach travel, workshop and theatre tickets. Students will need to meet at school in the Drama Studio no later than 8.15am as the coach will be leaving school at 8.30am prompt. Our return coach will arrive back at school at approximately 6.30pm and students should wear clothing suitable for movement. There are 30 places available on this visit and places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis.

If you would like your child to attend the visit, please complete the permission slip attached and return it to the Drop Box outside Student Reception no later than Monday 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2016.

Cheques should be made payable to **Brine Leas School** and returned with the permission slip in an envelope to the Drop Box outside Student Reception.

Cash payments can be accepted when a cheque is not possible. Students must take cash payments direct to the Finance Office for a receipt to be provided.

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals / has in the past been on Free School Meals since 2009 / is currently a Child in Service since January 2011/ is currently a Cared for Child or has ever been look after by an English or Welsh local authority immediately before being adopted, left local authority care on a special guardianship or child arrangements order, then the visit will be paid for through the Pupil Premium Fund. Please return the form attached with the Pupil Premium Payment option on the reply slip ticked. If your form is returned to school showing the Pupil Premium option and we don't appear to have your child on our Pupil Premium records we may need to contact you to clarify.

It is the policy of Brine Leas to support families when financial hardship may preclude a student from attending a visit, therefore if you have any problems, please contact Mrs K Bradshaw and the matter will be dealt with confidentially.


