Dear Parent/Guardian

Your son/daughter has expressed an interest in applying to Oxford or Cambridge University this year. In order to help students decide whether they should/could apply, and to ensure they have all the information they need regarding the application process, we have arranged a visit to the Cambridge Open Day on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> and Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2018.

The visit includes a tour and talk at Fitzwilliam College on arrival on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July, followed by the Open Day, on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July. Two members of staff will accompany the students to Cambridge for the duration of the visit, and will co-ordinate the events on the Open Day. Students will be free to attend events during the Open Day, but both members of staff will be contactable by mobile telephone and at pre-arranged meeting points throughout the day.

The cost of this visit is £75, which includes the cost of travel by minibus to/from the event plus accommodation on a bed and breakfast basis. Students will need to bring money for an evening meal on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July and for lunch and refreshments the following day. We will leave BL6 at 2.30pm on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> July, returning at approximately 8.30pm on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> July, traffic dependent.

Please note that the booking for the Open Day itself must be made by the student via the website as it is not possible to make group bookings. The booking system is not yet open, but should be available by the end of April via the following website:

As there are only 8 places available, they will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. To confirm your son/daughter's place, please complete and return the attached reply slip, together with completed Form C and payment, as soon as possible. Cheques should be made payable to Brine Leas School and returned to **the Finance Office in the main school**; cash payments can be accepted when a cheque is not possible. If your son/daughter is in receipt of the BL6 Bursary, the cost may be deducted from their next instalment; please indicate this on the reply slip.

It is the policy of Brine Leas to support families when financial hardship may preclude a student from attending a school visit. Therefore, if there are any problems, please contact Mrs K Bradshaw and the matter will be dealt with confidentially.
