Re: Year 11 Exam Arrangements

Dear Parents / Guardians,

The Year 11 exams are fast approaching and commence on Monday 14th May 2018. With this in mind, I would like to take this opportunity to inform parents, guardians and students about the arrangements for the weeks that will follow.

The start times of examinations are not flexible and will begin promptly at either 9.00am or 1.15pm. I therefore advise that students should be arriving at school for 8.15am if they have a morning examination or 12.30pm if their exam falls in the afternoon.

During the morning examinations for English, Maths and Science, complimentary hot refreshments will be available for all Year 11 students from 8.15am in the canteen. In addition, there will be several classrooms available for student study. Please note, all students' examination timetables are now available to view on the school VLE.

Full school uniform will apply for all examinations. If your child has purchased a school hoodie, the hoodie will be permitted during their exam but students must still wear a school shirt and tie underneath. Trainers, jeans and sweatshirts may not be worn and any students who do not arrive in their full school uniform could be turned away from the exam hall. Please see the school Uniform Policy online for clarification if necessary.

All equipment must be in a clear plastic wallet / pencil case and students should ensure that they have the right equipment for each specific exam. Mobile phones are not permitted in the examination hall so we would advise that students do not bring them into school.

Finally, students are expected to attend school throughout the exam period as lessons and masterclasses will take place until the examinations finish.
