

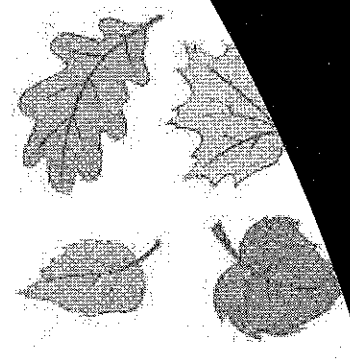

The mock examinations are approaching (specific dates are on the school website) and so we would like to request that all students have a copy of the play (An Inspector Calls) from which to revise. A full re-read of this text should be done leading up to the exam. Notes and highlighting should be evident in the text, if it's to be put to good use. This cannot be taken into the exam, however.

The following areas will be assessed in November:

Full English Literature Paper 2 - An Inspector Calls and Poetry (Conflict and Unseen)
Full English Language Paper 2 (revised after half-term)

Now is a good idea to go through English folders with your child to ensure that detailed notes, worksheets and essays are present. At this point in Year 11, files should feel heavy and full. Dividers and plastic wallets should be a feature of any well-organised folder.

After half-term, some groups will be re-reading A Christmas Carol (teachers will inform the students concerned), so please ensure that your child has a copy. The purchase of revision guides is also a good idea; second-hand copies are absolutely fine.
