Re: Years 11 & 12 Educational STEM Rollercoaster Experience visit to Disneyland Paris - Tuesday 20th February – Friday 23rd February 2018

The Mathematics Department is planning to organise an educational tour to Disneyland Paris which is arranged by external company Study Experiences. The tour provides an exclusive opportunity for students to discover how their subject is put into practice at this world famous leisure destination.

During their time at Disneyland Paris, students will attend two educational seminars and an interactive workshop and will work on a number of assignment projects directly related to their classroom studies of Mathematics and application of Science and Technology. Due the level of knowledge expected, the experience is suitable for those students who are studying or plan to study Mathematics at A-level.

The seminars and workshop will take key learning points from classroom studies and show how they are put into practice at Disneyland Paris. They have been created by one of the UK's leading education providers and involve Disney staff and managers, backstage video footage and practical information to help bring the curriculum to life. Study Experiences is an assured member of the School Travel Forum. The School Travel Forum is a group of leading-school tour operators who promote good practice and safety in school travel. Due to the imminence of the date of this visit, we have some tight deadlines in order for bookings and payments to be processed successfully.

If you would like your child to take part in this educational tour, please complete the permission slip attached and return it to school with the non-refundable deposit no later than **Tuesday 10th October 2017** to secure your place on the trip. Due to the limited number of places replies will be treated on a '**first come first served basis**', however Year 12 will be given priority due to the A-level nature of the course.

There are two payment options:

- a) Payment in full by Tuesday 10th October 2017
or
- b) Payment by 3 instalments as follows:
 - 1. Initial deposit: £150 by Tuesday 10th October 2017
 - 2. Second payment: £150 by Friday 10th November 2017
 - 3. Final payment: £60 by Friday 8th December 2017

Cheques should be made payable to **Brine Leas School** and returned with the reply slip in an envelope to the Drop Box situated outside Student Reception.

Cash payments can be accepted when a cheque payment is not possible. **Students must take cash payments direct to the Finance Office and a receipt will be issued.**


