Re: Curriculum Week – Year 10

I am writing to inform you about what will be taking place at school week commencing Monday 22nd October, 2018. Curriculum Week will be taking place from Monday – Friday during which time normal lessons do not take place. This is the schools opportunity to provide your child with the chance to experience learning in a different way.

As a year 10 student your child will be doing a variety of activities including:

- A day with the Science department carrying on with GCSE science curriculum, activities may include skills enhancement, required practical activities and assessments.
- Option Subjects for half a day each
- Students will have workshops ran by an organisation called **Zebra Red**. These workshops are based around preventing violent extremism and radicalisation, recognising the importance of having a socially cohesive society, where people can learn to identify, manage and live with difference.
- A day completing CV's and developing Life skills. As technology increasingly shapes the world of work, more importance is being placed on skills like problem solving and resilience to succeed in this changing environment. Barclays have created resources that help to prepare 11-24 year olds to move forward in the 21st century workplace. Students will be completing tasks that will help them prepare for the world of work and their future careers using this LifeSkills programme.
