Re: Visit to 'Life is a Dream' ballet

Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are very excited to invite your child to the matinee performance of the Rambert ballet company's performance of 'Life is a Dream' at the Lowry theatre. It is the company's first full length narrative dance work for over 30 years and we have managed to secure excellent seats for the production at a very reduced rate.

The visit is on Thursday 11th October 2018 and we will be leaving school at 11.30am, returning at approximately 4.00pm. As we will be returning after the school buses have gone please make arrangements to collect your child, alternatively you can give permission for them to make their own way home by completing the section on the permission slip.

The cost of the visit will be £24 including the ticket and return coach journey.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them as we will not have time to buy anything and will be leaving over break time at school. However if your child is entitled to Free School Meals we can provide a packed lunch from the canteen should you wish us to do so. Please complete the section on the permission slip below. Students will need to come into school wearing their school uniform, but may also bring a change of clothes if they wish to change before we leave.

It is the policy of Brine Leas to support families when financial hardship may preclude a student from attending a visit, therefore if you have any problems, please contact Mrs K Bradshaw and the matter will be dealt with confidentially.

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals / has in the past been on Free School Meals since 2012 / is currently a Child in Service since January 2012/ is currently a Cared for Child or has ever been looked after by an English or Welsh local authority then some assistance can be applied for through the Pupil Premium Fund. Please return the permission slip below with the Pupil Premium assistance application ticked. The school will contact you to advise what assistance is available. If your form is returned to school showing the Pupil Premium option and we don't appear to have your child on our Pupil Premium records we may need to contact you to clarify.
