### Re: Theatre Visit – Regent Theatre

Dear Parent / Guardian

The Drama Department is running a theatre visit as part of the year 10 and 12 GCSE, BTEC and A Level courses, to give students the opportunity to see an excellent professional production of 'Blood Brothers'. We have tickets booked for the evening performance at The Regent Theatre Stoke, on **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2018 at 7.30pm**. The visit is an excellent opportunity for students to watch and review a professional performance of the production they will be studying as part of their course. It will also form part of their external exams so it is vital that your child attends.

The cost of the visit is £27.00 (cheque payment preferred) which covers the coach travel and theatre tickets. Students may take cash payments directly to the Finance Office and this will be receipted in the student's planner.

Students will leave school on the coach at 6.30pm and will arrive back at school at approximately 10.30pm. Please make arrangements to collect your child.

If you would like your child to attend the visit, please complete the reply slip below and return to school with a cheque payment (the preferred option) for £27.00 to the Drop Box outside Student Reception. I have also enclosed a Form C (Parental Permission). Please complete this form and return it along with the permission slip and payment to the Drop Box outside Student Reception no later than **Friday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2018**. Unfortunately, without this form being completed your child will not be able to attend the visit.

If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals / has in the past been on Free School Meals since 2012 / is currently a Child in Service since January 2012/ is currently a Cared for Child or has ever been looked after by an English or Welsh local authority then some assistance can be applied for through the Pupil Premium Fund. Please return the permission slip below with the Pupil Premium assistance application ticked. The school will contact you to advise what assistance is available. If your form is returned to school showing the Pupil Premium option and we don't appear to have your child on our Pupil Premium records we may need to contact you to clarify
