Dear Parents/Guardians

I am writing to inform you about an exciting project taking place at school week commencing Monday 21st October, 2019. Curriculum Week will be taking place from Monday – Friday during which time normal lessons do not take place. This is the school's opportunity to provide your child with the chance to experience learning in a different way.

As a year 8 student your child will be doing a variety of activities which will include:

- ICreate - A visiting theatre company will deliver a 'Brush up your Shakespeare' workshop exploring the works of Shakespeare and performance skills.
- Science – Inter House Science competition
- Languages - A day with the MFL department doing a film study
- Humanities – The RE department have organised for a range of speakers to come into school to talk to students about their faith, career journeys and the importance of community cohesion in a multi ethnic society.
- Enterprise is about enabling young people to develop the knowledge and attitudes they need to succeed, building on key skills: Communication, Confidence, Financial Capability, Initiative, Organisation, Problem-solving, Teamwork and Resilience.
- Technology – Students will be developing their Technical skills
- Maths – Students will be looking at careers in Maths


If your child is currently eligible for Free School Meals assistance is available funded by the school to cover the contribution, please choose the FSM option on WisePay.
