

HPV VACCINATION Information for Parents of Year 8 and 9 girls and boys

Immunisation sessions in all our High Schools for both year 8 and year 9 pupils will be offered after the Easter holidays.

Attached is a list of dates for HPV sessions in all our High Schools for both year 8 and year 9 pupils.

FAO Year 8 parents/carers:

All year 8 girls and boys are now due their 1st dose of HPV and you will have recently received a consent form via school which we would ask you to complete and return to school asap.

FAO Year 9 parents/carers:

Year 9 boys and girls are now due their 2nd HPV dose.

If you agreed to your child receiving the 1st dose of HPV vaccination last year you will already have signed a consent form which asked for your agreement for us to vaccinate your son/daughter with the 2 dose of HPV.

The second dose will complete the course of these immunisations and your child will be fully protected.

Please ignore this reminder if your child is in year 9 and you do not wish your child to be immunised with HPV and have already refused.

Year 9 parents please note

You will be receiving a further consent form for your child's DTP/Men ACWY immunisation to be offered in school in due course.

If a child is unwell or unable to have the vaccine on the planned day, they will be offered the vaccination in a catch-up session at the school. These will be arranged at short notice, and it will not be possible to let pupils or their parents know about them in advance.
