We are pleased and excited to announce the inaugural Year 12 residential visit which will take place at The Lakeside Centre on the shores of Windermere lake, Cumbria from Monday 26th September to Wednesday 28th September 2022. The residential is a new aspect of the school's transition programme for students joining our sixth form in 2022. It will be an essential part of our transition process as students will enjoy three days dedicated to fostering relationships and community spirit within the sixth form. The trip is a fantastic opportunity for all students to immerse themselves in what will be a challenging, rewarding and entertaining trip in the wonderful surroundings of Windermere lake.

We have chosen The Lakeside Centre in Newby Bridge for this visit. Whilst the centre is very well established, the accommodation that Brine Leas will occupy is in the new Stroller Campus. As a school, we have frequented the Lakeside Centre with previous residentials for several years.

Students will be partaking in a bespoke programme which has been tailored to their three-day residential.
