

Year 7 Catch up premium

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium provides schools with an additional £500 for each year 7 pupil who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2.

2013-14

At Brine Leas we received £12,500 which was for 18 children who were below level 4 in Maths and 15 children below level 4 in English. numeracy and literacy are the building blocks for every subject and the aim is to improve both.

Funding was spent on

Staff responsibility costs for running the Accelerated Reader Programme and additional teaching costs involved in Parent Engagement £7,967

Contributing towards the cost of Accelerated reader- a software package that is used in the library to encourage reading including annual licences at a cost of £2,786

Reducing class sizes/small group tutoring in English and Maths ££7,945

TA support Grade 4, 3 hours per week £1,400

The Nurture Group, 14 students, two staff on UPS2 and 3 Average 14/43 £12,000

By the end of the year 13 children had moved from level 3 or below in English and 5 children had moved from level 3 or below in Maths.

2014-15

At Brine Leas we estimate we will receive £11,000 which is for 15 children who were below level 4 in Maths and 14 children below level 4 in English. numeracy and literacy are the building blocks for every subject and the aim is to improve both.

Funding in 2014-15 will be spent again on

recruiting additional staff

Staff responsibility costs for running the Accelerated Reader Programme and additional teaching costs involved in Parent Engagement £8,750

contributing towards the cost of Accelerated reader- a software package that is used in the library to encourage reading as above plus 3% estimated increase £2,870

We intend to research for a Maths product equivalent to Accelerated Reader estimated cost £2,500

reducing class sizes/small tutoring groups £8,500

TA support Grade 4, 3 hours per week £1,500

The Nurture Group, estimate 16 students same staff £14,000
