Year 8 Residential Visit 8-12th November 2021

Dear Parents/Guardians/Carers,

The Year 8 residential visit will be taking place from Monday 8th to Friday 12th November 2021. One-half of the year group will take part in the residential from Monday 8th and return to school on Wednesday 10th. The other half will take part in their residential from Wednesday 10th and return to school on Friday 12th.

For many years, we have considered the residential to be an essential part of our transition process. Children engage with team building activities, make friends and fully join in the house system.

Our residential takes place on the shores of Windermere. The centre is very well established and the accommodation that Brine Leas will occupy is the recently built Stroller Campus. The centre offers a great range of activities for your child to enjoy.

The Year 8 Visit booklet included will give you more information about the trip and I hope this will answer some of the questions you may have. In the autumn term, we will provide a specific timetable of activities for the visit.
