



## The BL6 Application Process

Look at the courses on offer at BL6

1. Carefully look at all the courses available, read the course guides and make sure you choose courses that you are interested and/or ones that you are going to achieve highly. Speak to subject specialists and discuss with your parents. Select 4 courses by ranking them in order of preference, with 1 being your most preferred choice and 4 as your reserve choice.
2. Complete our application form, available at School or via our website.
3. Attend our informal independent advice and guidance meeting to discuss your chosen studies, extra-curricular interests as well as your next steps.
4. Receive a conditional offer letter. This conditional offer is based on the courses discussed during the IAG session. If you would like to alter one or more of your choices, you should contact the BL6 admin team as soon as possible. If there are spaces on the course, you will be added to the provisional class list, otherwise your name will be added to a waiting list and when a space becomes available their name will be added.
5. Come along to our subject taster sessions, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> July, to confirm your choices.
6. Attend a second advice and guidance session upon enrolment to confirm your subject choices following GCSE results publication. Enrolment is from August 24<sup>th</sup>.
