Supporting with course work

The students need to complete a design folder and practical garment.

By Christmas they should have cut out and assembled their garment ready to decorate and embellish during the next few weeks.

They need to produce samples of the decoration they could potentially use.

For example: beading, printing and Applique samples to show the examiner potential decorative and construction techniques.

They can produce some work at home and in school.
