- 4. Practise!! This exam is skills over knowledge. Complete questions and get them marked (there are past questions on the website above or you can get them from your teacher).
- 5. Write pieces of description with a thesaurus so that you enhance your vocabulary especially for things like colours. Go back through your stories have you opened your sentences in a variety of ways? Have you used a variety of punctuation? Have you used personification? How is it structured in an interesting way?
